As most of you know, we are working on a new contract, our current contract expires Feb. 2011. We would like to know what items you feel should be addressed. The attached "Dream Sheet" is in contract paragraph order and should be able to be followed easily. Go over our current contract, and notate the items that you feel should be addressed. Then list the top 5 items you feel should be addressed in order of their importance to you. You do not have to identify yourself .

Don't include wages, as we know that is everyone's top priority. We need to know what else you feel should be changed and/or safeguarded. We need everyone to respond, so we get concerns from reserves, line holders, full time, and part time flight attendants. We know each group has it's own problems and ideas on how to improve our relations with the company.

We need to have this info back by the end of ~~May~~, so we can put together a contract that has no more "Gray" areas that we have currently. I know many of you think that your representatives are not doing the job you expect; however, if we get a good contract, that does not have 3 or 4 interpretations in every paragraph, their jobs will be made easier. As a matter of information, each base has a contract committee. In July, the chairmen of each committee are going to meet in DTW and combine notes, ideas, and your concerns. At that point, a feasibility study will determine how we will approach the major concerns, and how to implement them into the new contract.
